What is Eternal Life?

It is the new life that

1. Has a personal relationship with God (Jn 17:3)
2. Is deemed righteous and will no longer suffer eternal punishment and death (Mt 25:46)
3. Is given freely (Rom 6:23b)
4. Will satisfy us completely (Jn 4:14)
5. Culminates in eternal goodness and glory (2 Cor 4:17)
6. Starts the moment we believe in Jesus (Jn 3:36a)
