

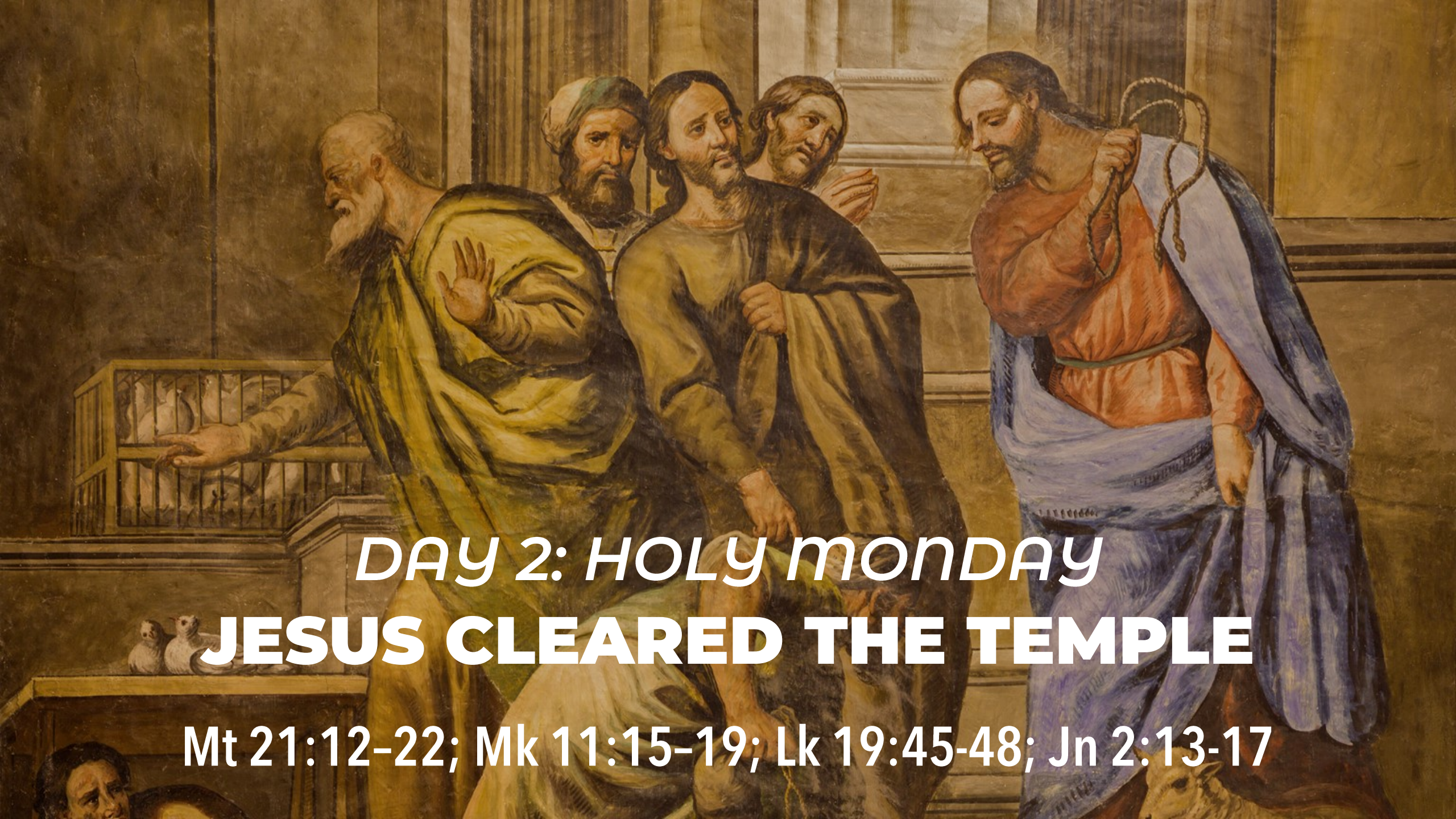

Mt 21:23-24:51; Mk 11:20-13:37; Lk 20:1-21:36; Jn 12:20-38

DAY 4: HOLY WEDNESDAY

JESUS RESTED

DAY 5: MAUNDY THURSDAY

- Jesus washed the disciples feet
- Jesus partook the Passover Meal with His disciples
- Jesus established the Lord's Supper/Communion
- **Jesus prayed at the Garden of Gethsamane**
- Jesus was betrayed by Judas
- Jesus was arrested by the Sanhedrin
- Jesus' disciples deserted Him and fled

Mk 14:32-42

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

1. His **Focus/Passion** - v.32a

They went to a place called Gethsemane

2. His **Instruction** - v.32b

And Jesus said to his disciples, "Sit here while I pray."

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

3. His **Buddies** (Close Companions) - v.33a

He took Peter, James and John along with Him

4. His **Distress** - v.33b

and He began to be deeply distressed and troubled.

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

5. His **Anguish** - v.34a

My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death," he said to them.

6. His **Instruction** - v.34b

Stay here and keep watch.

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

7. His **Determination** – v.35a

Going a little farther,

8. His **Wish/Longing/Desire** – v.35b

He fell to the ground and prayed that if possible the hour might pass from him.

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

9. His **Relationship** with God - v.36a

Abba, Father,

10. His **Faith/Belief** - v.36b

Everything is possible for you.

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

11. His ***Request/Appeal*** – v.36c

Take this cup from me.

12. His ***Resolve/Submission*** – v.36d

Yet not what I will, but what you will.

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

13. His **Disappointment** - v.37

Then he returned to his disciples and found them sleeping. "Simon," he said to Peter, "are you asleep? Couldn't you keep watch for one hour?"

14. His **Counsel/Warning** - v.38

Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

15. His **Persistence** - v.39

Once more he went away and prayed the same thing.

16. His **Dismay** - v.40

When he came back, he again found them sleeping, because their eyes were heavy. They did not know what to say to him.

Observations and Lessons from Jesus' Agonies

17. His **Rebuke** and **Anticipation** - v.41

Returning the third time, he said to them, "Are you still sleeping and resting? Enough! The hour has come. Look, the Son of Man is delivered into the hands of sinners.

18. His **Concern** - v.42

Rise! Let us go! Here comes my betrayer!

CHALLENGE

Present yourself to the Lord and tell Him:

1. I want Your Will done in my life = **Total Surrender**

Not my will, Lord, but Yours be done.

2. I want You to live in and through me = **Total Dependence**

Not by might, nor by power, but by Your Spirit
