



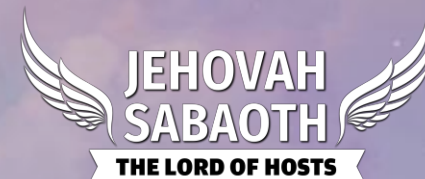

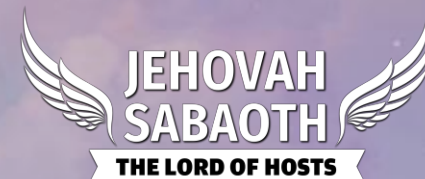

1. The Meaning of Jehovah Sabaoth

JEHOVAH

- The Self-existent One, the Creator, the one True and Mighty God; the Great I Am.
- He is **Omnipotent** (all-powerful), **Omnipresent** (everywhere present), **Omniscient** (all-knowing) and **Omnibenevolence** (supremely good)

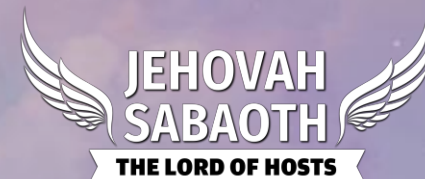


1. The Meaning of Jehovah Sabaoth

SABAOTH

- An army or a group of warriors - 1 Sam. 17:45
- Hosts of heaven - stars/angels – Ps. 148:2; Isa. 40:26

Whether it is armies, warriors, angels or stars,
Jehovah, who alone is Great and Almighty, **is above all and rules over all things and all forces** on earth and in heaven.



2. Jehovah Sabaoth in the Old Testament

This name appeared more than **270** times in the OT

Two familiar stories in I Samuel on Jehovah Sabaoth

1. 1 Samuel 1:1-3, 11

2. 1 Samuel 17:45-51

1 Samuel 1:1-3

There was a certain man of Ramathaim-zophim of the hill country of Ephraim whose name was **Elkanah** the son of Jeroham, son of Elihu, son of Tohu, son of Zuph, an Ephrathite.

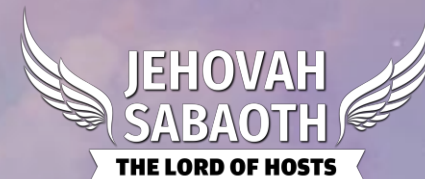
² He had two wives. The name of the one was **Hannah**, and the name of the other, **Peninnah**. And Peninnah had children, but Hannah had no children.

³ Now this man used to go up year by year from his city to worship and to sacrifice to **the Lord of hosts** at Shiloh, where the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were priests of the Lord.

1 Samuel 1:11

And Hannah vowed a vow and said, “**O Lord of hosts**, if you will indeed **look** on the affliction of your servant and **remember** me and **not forget** your servant, but will **give** to your servant a son, then **I will give him to the Lord** all the days of his life, and no razor shall touch his head.”

you and hear your prayer when you cry out to Him
and cast all your cares and anxieties on Him.**



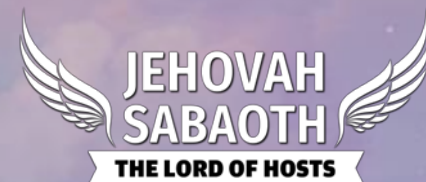
Psalm 34:6

1 Sam 17:45-51 (ESV)

⁴⁵ Then David said to the Philistine, “You come to me with a sword and with a spear and with a javelin, but **I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel,** whom you have **defied.**

⁴⁶ This day **the Lord will deliver you into my hand,** and I will strike you down and cut off your head. And I will give the dead bodies of the host of the Philistines this day to the birds of the air and to the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel,



1 Sam 17:45-51 (ESV)

⁴⁷ and that all this assembly may know that the Lord saves not with sword and spear. **For the battle is the Lord's**, and he will give you into our hand."

⁴⁸ When the Philistine arose and came and drew near to meet David, **David ran quickly toward the battle line** to meet the Philistine.

⁴⁹ And David put his hand in his bag and took out a stone and slung it and struck the Philistine on his forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell on his face to the ground.

1 Sam 17:45-51 (ESV)

⁵⁰ So David prevailed over the Philistine **with a sling and with a stone**, and struck the Philistine and killed him. There was no sword in the hand of David.

⁵¹ Then David ran and stood over the Philistine and took his sword and drew it out of its sheath and killed him and cut off his head with it. When the Philistines saw that their champion was dead, they fled.

of need.**



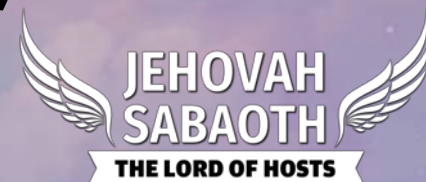
Ephesians 6:10-13

¹¹ **Put on the whole armor of God**, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil.

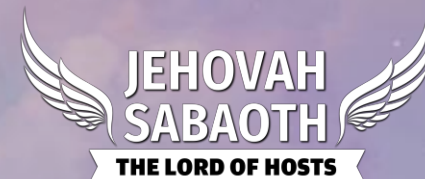

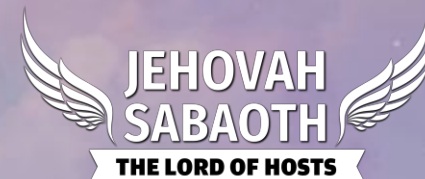

3. Jehovah Sabaoth in the New Testament

Jehovah Sabaoth is Great and Almighty, and He is above all and rules over all things and all forces on earth and in heaven.

When Jesus was on earth, He displayed His power and might over the forces of Satan and of Nature.



A. He healed the sick, the blind, the lame, the leper, the deaf and cast out demons and control them (Mk 1:34; Lk 8:26-39; Mt 11:5)

Mark 1:34

And He healed many who were sick with various diseases and cast out many demons. And He would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew Him.

Luke 8:26-39

³² A large herd of pigs was feeding there on the hillside. The **demons begged Jesus** to let them go into the pigs, and **He gave them permission.**

³³ When the demons came out of the man, they went into the pigs, and the herd rushed down the steep bank into the lake and was drowned.

Matthew 11:5

The **blind** receive sight, the **lame** walk,
those who have **leprosy** are cleansed,
the **deaf** hear, the **dead** are raised, and
the **good news** is proclaimed to the poor.

B. He raised the dead to life – Jairus' daughter (Mt. 9:18-26), Only son of a widow (Lk. 7:11-17), Lazarus (Jn. 11:1-44).

C. He ruled over the storm, the wind, and the waves
(Mk 4:35-41)

D. He had all authority in heaven and on earth
(Mt 28:18)

E. He overcame the world (Jn 16:33)

F. He redeemed us, destroyed the devil, and delivered us from the bondage of sin (Heb 2:14-15)

G. He had (and still has) a name which is above every name (Phil 2:10-11)

Philippians 2:10-11

¹⁰ That at the **name of Jesus** every **knee** should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

¹¹ and every **tongue** acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Isaiah 44:6

Thus says the Lord, the King of Israel, and his **Redeemer**, the Lord of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; besides Me there is no God.

Isaiah 47:4

Our **Redeemer**—the **Lord of hosts** is his name—is the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 54:5

For your Maker is your husband, **The Lord of hosts** is His name; and your **Redeemer** is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the **God of the whole earth.**



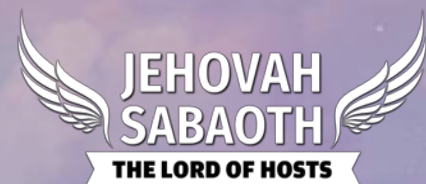
Revelation 1:11

Psalm 34:15-17

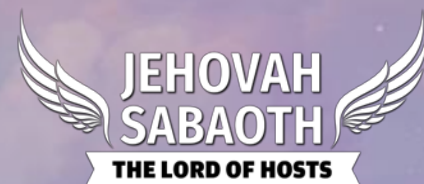
15 The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are attentive to their cry.
