Lk 18:9 To some who were confident of their own righteousness and looked down on everybody else, Jesus told this parable: 10 Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. 11 The Pharisee stood up and prayed about himself: "God, I thank you that I am not like other men - robbers, evildoers, adulterers - or even like this tax collector. 12 I fast twice a week and give a tenth of all I get." 13 But the tax collector stood at a distance. He would not even look up to heaven, but beat his breast and said, "God, have mercy on me, [the] sinner." 14 I tell you that this man, rather than the other, went home justified before God. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

What the Pharisee did Right

- 1) Adopted right practice of going to Temple to pray (v.9)
- 2) Practised marital fidelity not an adulterer; upheld ethics didn't commit robbery (v.11)
- 3) Fasted twice a week (v.12)
- 4) Paid tithes for his wealth and for the gifts he received

WRONG WAY TO PRAY

prayed about himself (NIV) prayed to himself (NASB)

Mt 6:5

when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites ...for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners to be seen... they have received their reward in full

Mt 6:7

when you pray, do not pray like the pagans ... for they think they will be heard because of their many words

RICHT WAY TO PRAY

He stood at a distance (v.13a)

He would not even look up to heaven (v.13b)

He beat his breast and cried: "God, have mercy on me, [the] sinner" (v.13c)

The Principle

IThe Publican1, rather than Ithe Pharisee1, went home justified before God. For everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted (v.14).



1 Cor 14:15 Eph 6:18 Jude 20

1 Corinthians 14:15 (NLT)

Well then, what shall I do? I will do <u>both</u>. I will pray in the spirit, and I will pray in words I understand. I will sing in the spirit, and I will sing in words I understand.

Now about spiritual gifts... I do not want you to be ignorant

1 Corinthians 14:15 (NLT)

a

Different kinds of gifts (12:4)
Different kinds of service (12:5)
Different kinds of working (12:6)

to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good.

Gifts of the Holy Spirit

1the message of wisdom; 2the message of knowledge; 3gifts of healing; 4faith; 5miraculous powers; 5prophecy; 7distinguishing between spirits; 8speaking in different kinds of tongues; 9interpretation of tongues.

But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as He wanted them to be.

...there should be no division in the Body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other.

And now I will show you the most excellent way...

1 Cor 14:6

Now brothers, if I come to you and speak in tongues, what good will I be to you, unless I bring you some revelation or knowledge or prophecy or word of instruction?

1 Cor 14:40

But everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way.

Rom 8:26 (ESV)

...the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And [God] who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.



Pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.



Main clause: pray in the spirit

Subordinate phrases: at all times & with all kinds of prayers



Praying in Spirit

an attitude in which the praying Christian rises to an intensely penetrating atmosphere created by the Spirit
