#### James 1:23-24

<sup>23</sup> Anyone who **listens** to the word **but** does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror <sup>24</sup> and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.



#### **James 1:25**

Perfect law that gives freedom, and continues in it—not forgetting what they have heard, but doing it—they will be blessed in what they do.



# 4 Steps to Blessings:

#### 1. LOOK INTENTLY

Look closely, attentively, fully and deeply into the Word to see what it says about your life and for your life.

**Read, study, meditate and memorise** the Word — to **BE** what God wants you to **Be** and **DO** what He wants you to **Do**.



#### John 8:31-32

31 To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. 32 Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.



# 4 Steps to Blessings:

#### 2. CONTINUES IN IT

Don't stop looking. Keep on looking and focusing to find out more or till things becomes crystal clear to your soul and spirit.



# 4 Steps to Blessings:

#### 3. NOT FORGETTING

Don't forget what you have discovered or what was spoken to you.



# 4 Steps to Blessings: 4. DOING IT

Obey and do what you have read, learned, heard, instructed, and told.

Let His word soften your hardened heart and change your life.

You will be blessed.
You will be successful in what you do.
