**A. HE IS THE SPIRIT OF THE
INFINITE GOD**

Genesis 1:2,

When we know the Holy Spirit resides in us:


1. It puts us on our knees in humility.

John 14:16-17,


“¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— ¹⁷ the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.”




Two Greek words for, “**Another**” It is used all through the NT and they are “**Heteros**” *another of a different sort* and “**Allos**” *another of a same kind*.



“Helper” In Greek translated
“Parakletos” it means – it speaks of a
lawyer that pleads someone’s case; a
personal counsellor or coach.







“PARA” & “KALEO”

“PARA” means – very close, side by side

“KALEO” means – is to beckon or to call



“The Holy Spirit is permanently called along side of us to coach us in our life walk with God. It is His calling and assignment and He does it permanently, because Jesus said He will abide with you forever. He will not leave you nor forsake you.



John 14:26 (AMP)

“But the Helper (Comforter, Advocate, Intercessor—Counselor, Strengthenener, Standby), the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will help you remember everything that I have told you.”
