- To receive knowledge, wisdom, discernment, guidance, direction, favour, blessing

# A. A Place of Gathering Together

- To unify family members and strengthen family ties
- To pray and believe God for signs, wonders, and miracles: healing, breakthrough, answers to problems and challenges, etc.

The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles.



## B. A Place of Exhibiting Faith

- To worship God and exalt His Holy Name
- To teach and share the Word of God
- To trust God for the impossible
- To pray against demonic attacks, influence and ideologies



## B. A Place of Exhibiting Faith

- To prophesy over the children and release them into their prophetic destinies
- To teach the ordinances of our faith and practice our spiritual beliefs: speaking in tongues, partaking of Holy Communion, praying with anointing oil, etc.

# **Deuteronomy 11:18-21**

- d. Keep the fire of God burning in our heart and home (cf. Lev 6:12-13)



# 2. Why is it important to have a Family Altar at home?

## We come together to:

- e. Remain fervent in Spirit, serving the Lord (Rom 12:11)
- f. Be faithful to the Lord to the end (Mt 24:13; Rev 2:10)



#### A. Be Serious and Intentional

Consecrate and dedicate
a particular room or area in your home
(e.g., living room, study room, bedroom, dining area)



#### A. Be Serious and Intentional

I have chosen and consecrated this temple so that my Name may be there forever. My eyes and my heart will always be there. (2 Chr 7:16)



#### **B.** Be Consistent

Make it a top priority.

Make it a habit.



#### C. Be Creative

Get everyone involved! (1 Cor 14:26)

- One can lead in worship
- One read a short passage of Scripture
- One explains the passage read briefly
- One by one pray and all affirm and agree



#### C. Be Creative

Get everyone involved! (1 Cor 14:26)

- One or two pray for needs and requests presented
- Everyone cheers and encourages each other
- Parents pray blessing or prophesy over the children.



#### C. Be Creative

Get everyone involved! (1 Cor 14:26)

It should not be too long nor routine, dull and boring.



D. Be Sensitive to the Leading of the Holy Spirit

But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."
