L THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

A. Jesus is the TRUE LIGHT

1. Apparent Connection

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. 2 Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters. 3 And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. 4 God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. 5 God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning the first day.

1. Apparent Connection

JN 1:1-9

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. 2 The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us. 3 We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. 4 We write this to make our joy complete.

5 This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all. 6 If we claim to have fellowship with him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth. 7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all[b] sin.


8 If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. 9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

1. Apparent Connection

- Both spoke light & darkness
- Gen: God created light & separated it from darkness
- John: pointed Jesus as the true light

7. TABERNACLES

- celebrated and commemorated Israelites 40 yrs wandering
- 2 important ceremonies:
 - Pouring of water: God's provision of water from rock
 - Festival of lights: God's guidance as a pillar of fire
- 4 golden candlesticks lit up casting glow over Jerusalem



- Not Physical or temporal light
- Saviour of the world that brings life & salvation
- True light guides & leads us into a relationship with God
- "Whoever follows Jesus will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (Jn 8: 12b)

B. Jesus is the Light That Reveals & Quides Our Hearts
