Believers who live by faith will:

- Believe Jesus is the only begotten Son of God - God's greatest gift to mankind.
- Be true disciples of Christ who willingly deny themselves, take up their crosses and follow Jesus all the way.
- Love God wholeheartedly and love others sincerely.
- Read the Bible daily.
- Pray earnestly and sincerely.
- Attend church regularly and faithfully.

Believers who live by faith will:

- Be baptised in water to identify themselves with Christ.
- Admit and acknowledge that they own nothing.
- Give intentionally, willingly, cheerfully, generously, sacrificially, and **not grudgingly**.
- Submit their lives to God for His will and purposes to be done.
- Be fervent in spirit, serving the Lord joyfully.

Believers who live by faith will:

- Use their talents, skills, giftings, abilities, resources for the glory of God.
- Acknowledge that without Christ they are nothing and can do nothing.
- Be careful to give God all the honour and glory.
- Prepare themselves to meet God anytime.

Believers who live by faith will:

- Know their suffering on earth is temporary.
- Face persecution for living a godly life.
- Persevere to the end.
- Live by faith with **joy and thanksgiving**, not with complaining and murmuring.
- Look forward to hearing Jesus say, “**Good and Faithful Servant ... Enter into the joy of your Lord.**”

And we know that **in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called** according to his purpose.
